Provides structured supervision, coaching, and evidence-based, cognitive behavioral interventions to youth placed on probation including motivational interviewing, Carey Guides, mediation, crisis intervention, monitoring behavior, conducting assessments, and developing/modifying case plans, to reduce recidivism and to minimize involvement in the juvenile justice system. Conducts home, school, and office visits, family team meetings, and other interactions within the community.
